Basic Function:

A committee established under Section 41 of the Local Government Act to facilitate, and coordinate projects for the advancement of the Martin Bend Recreation Area.

Specific Functions

- 1: To provide a forum for stakeholders to have input on proposals that affect the Martin Bend Recreational Area and use.
- 2: To plan improvements to the Martin Bend area that increase the visual amenity.
- 3: To assist in the establishment of projects to achieve greater community participation.
- 4: To develop a long-term co-ordinated and practical future program.
- 5: The Committee will make recommendations to the Council on implementation of its functions

Term of Office: Will expire at each Periodic Council Election.

Decision Making:

Council delegates its power pursuant to Section 41 of the Local Government Act to make decisions that do not have a financial impact on Council.

Register of Interest:

Pursuant to Section 72(1) of the Local Government Act 1999, the register of interest provisions as described in Division 2 "Register of Interest" do not apply to the committee members.
