Purpose

The Council has been granted joint care and control of Crown Land around Lake Bonney. Portions of this area have historically been utilised for the use of unclad bathing.

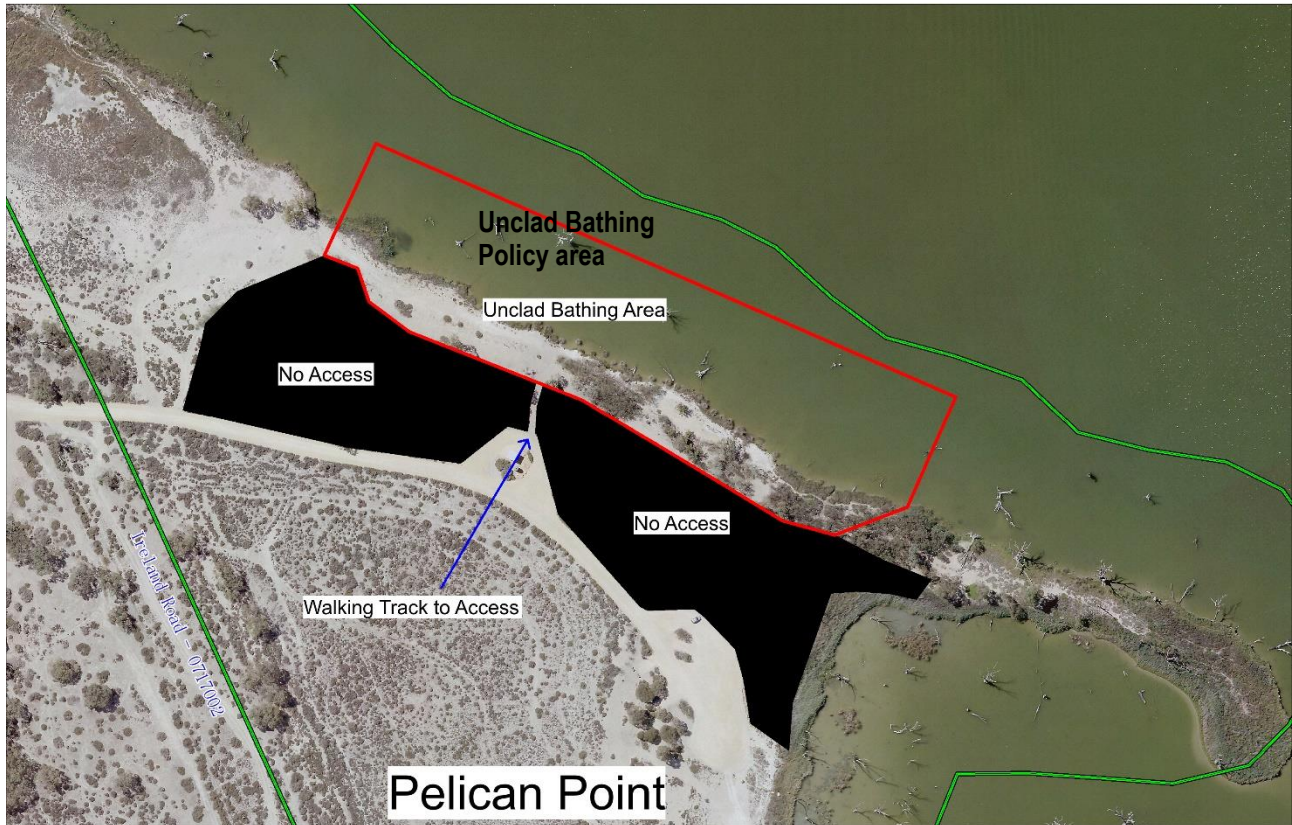
Council's By Law No. 3 – Local Government Land states under Section 3.2 that no person can cause an annoyance on Local Government land. The undertaking of unclad bathing could be constituted as a public annoyance under this clause.

Principles

The portion of land within Section 854 in the Cobdogla Irrigation Area identified in the attached maps referred to in Appendix 1 shall be reserved for the purpose of clad and unclad bathing and all persons using this portion of land shall be exempt from any penalty under By Law No. 3 – Local Government Land. Unclad bathing is prohibited on all other Local Government Land within the Berri Barmera Council.
