**Monash Centenary Military
Ceremony: 9am to 11am**
**This momentous occasion will
include a Remembrance Service,
and Commemoration March**

Monash is a WW1 soldier settler district named after the revered General Sir John Monash so it is fitting the town marks its 100th birthday with a military event. The Australian Army agree and are supporting this event with an amazing level of military pomp and ceremony.

This will include a formal military service with catafalque party, two marching bands and precision drill team.

This event is certainly one not to miss, as it coincides with the 100th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Monash on August 25, 1921.

**9.00am - 9.45am: Military
Ceremony**

Assemble early in front of the Monash Memorial Hall.

10.30am – 11am: Military March

The descendants of Monash's World War 1 Soldier Settler families are invited to take part in a Military March from the Monash Memorial Hall to Monash Primary School wearing the medals of their ancestors.

There will never be such an auspicious occasion for descendants to recognise the town's 150 soldier settlers.

 - Visit the historic Lone Gum tree on Lobban Rd

- Wander the grounds of the Monash Primary School ...and reminisce if you were a student there
- Stroll the streets of Monash or drive the district's roads to find your ancestor's fruit block and re-visit areas with childhood memories

- Visit a Monash winery or two

- Park behind Monash Primary School, around the school playground or on the town oval and walk to the Monash Memorial Hall via Madison Avenue, which will be closed to traffic.
