1. Purpose

That in the event of additional plaques being added to the structure in the future, those plaques be constructed in accordance with the conditions as listed below.

2. Definitions

Council	means Berri Barmera Council
Act	refer to Australia War Memorial Act 1980
Memorial	means the corporation established by subsection 4(1) under the name of the Australian War Memorial.

3. Principles

- That the group that wishes to place a plaque must have returned from an Australian Gazetted area of Conflict (i.e. entitled to a "Returned from Active Service Badge.)
- Future groups need to be granted permission from the Riverland Vietnam Veterans Association, Berri Barmera Council or the local RSL.
- Plaques are to be of the same size and character as those that are already in place. (The originals were purchased from Riverland Memorials, Hughes Street, Berri)

4. Policy Statement

Organisers of ceremonies relating to conflict (or future ones), need to liaise with the Berri Barmera Council. Use of the Memorial is to be encouraged.
