L Landfill - Red lidded bin

R Recycling - yellow lidded bin

G Green waste

R aerosol cans (empty)	R egg cartons	L nappies (disposable)
R aluminium cans	L egg shells	R newspapers
R aluminium foil (clean & balled up)	R envelopes (all types)	R paint tins (empty or dry)
L BBQ chicken bags	L fish scraps	L paper towel (food or drink spills)
R berry punnets	G flower bunches (no wrapping or foam)	R pet food tins (scraped clean)
R biscuit trays	L foam meat & veg trays	L pillows & other bedding
R bottle lids (plastic & metal)	R foil-lined cartons (juice, milk & stock)	R pizza boxes (emptied)
R bottles (glass and plastic)	L food waste (including meat & dairy)	L plastic bags (or REDcycle)
G branches	L fruit & vegetable scraps	R plastic bottles & containers
R cake trays (plastic)	R frypans (glass lids in red lidded bin)	R plastic plant pots (clean)
R cans (steel & aluminium)	G garden waste	R plastic plates/bowls/cups & cutlery
R cardboard (including toilet rolls)	L glass - window, mirror or pyrex	L polystyrene
L cassette and video tapes	R glass jars and bottles	L pyrex & other ovenware
L CDs	G grass clippings	R saucepans (glass lids in landfill bin)
L ceramics (broken mugs etc)	R hairspray cans (empty)	L seafood scraps & bones
L chip packets (or REDcycle)	R icecream containers & lids	R shampoo & conditioner bottles
L cigarette butts	R jar lids (plastic & metal)	L shoes (too worn to donate)
L cleaning rags	R junk mail	L soft plastic packaging (or REDcycle)
L clingwrap	L kitty (or other animal) litter	L soft toys (too worn to donate)
L clothing & shoes (non-donatable)	R laundry detergent boxes & bottles	R spray bottles (empty)
L coffee grounds & tea bags	G leaves	L styrofoam
R coffee tins & jars	R magazines	R takeaway containers (clean plastic)
R cooking oil containers (empty)	R margarine tubs & lids	L vacuum cleaner dust
R cosmetic jars (plastic & glass)	L meat bones & scraps	L vegetable scraps
L curtains & other textiles	L meat trays - polystyrene	L video tapes & cassettes
R cutlery (metal & plastic)	R meat trays - plastic (rinsed)	R yoghurt tubs of all sizes (rinsed)
R deodorant cans & roll-ons (empty)	R medicine & vitamin bottles (empty)	L yoghurt squeezies
R detergent bottles	R milk bottles & cartons	L zip lock bags (too dirty to reuse)
