

## Preparing for your collection

To help us make this collection a success we ask that items;

- Be sorted and placed in neat piles.
- Not exceed more than 2m<sup>3</sup> (two cubic metres).
- Be no longer than 2 metres.
- Be able to be lifted by 2 people
- Be placed in an accessible kerbside location on nature strip in front of your property, clear of footpath

Hard waste that doesn't meet these requirements will not be collected

Please avoid parking in front of collection piles.



## Uncollected items, too early or late presentation

To prevent the township from looking untidy during this time, residents are required to place items for collection only between **Monday 29 April and Sunday 5 May 2024.**

**\*\*Early and late placement may attract a fine under the *Local Nuisance and Litter Control Act.***

The Collection Service may not collect your waste if the following is present:

- Additional amount beyond the allowable limit of (2m<sup>3</sup>)
- Excluded materials

*Written notice will be provided to the resident if any waste is left uncollected.*

**Uncollected items must be removed by the resident within 24 hours.**

It is the residents responsibility to do this and failure to do so may attract a fine.

*\*Scavenging is not permitted*

# Small Towns Hard Waste Collection 6 - 10 May 2024

The Berri Barmera Council is providing a hard waste collection to residential properties within the small towns only.

## Dates for Collection 6 May - 10 May 2024

Small townships include:

- Cobdogla - Residential street address ONLY
- Glossop - Residential street address ONLY
- Loveday - Residential street address ONLY
- Monash - Residential street address ONLY
- Overland Corner - see below eligibility
- Winkie - 1 drop off point ONLY

For a residential property to be eligible they must be located within township boundaries, which is defined as having a street address (not a rural address), with the exception of the following areas:

**Overland Corner** - Residents of Old Coach Road ONLY.

**Winkie Residents ONLY** - Drop off next to Winkie Hall - **Saturday 4 May 2024 between 8:30am-3pm**

Excluded properties include, but are not limited to;

- Businesses
- Commercial premises
- Vacant land
- Industrial properties
- Schools, and
- Churches

### Acceptable Items

- Medium to large general waste items able to be handled by two people
- E-Waste items/domestic powered appliances
  - 1 x large item (2m X 1.5m only)
  - 2 x small items (1m X 1m)
- Empty paint tins (lids removed)
- Furniture, bedding, carpet, rugs and mats
- 1 x Mattress ONLY per household
- Gardening equipment, including electrical tools
- Polystyrene and other plastic packaging
- Pottery, crockery and wash basins
- Pyrex glass (e.g. microwave dishes)
- Intact mirrors
- Hot water units, tanks and empty drums able to be handled by two people
- Lawn mowers, small combustion equipment and metal tools
- Metal baths, roofing iron and guttering up to 2m in length and able to be handled by 2 people
- Small metal car parts weighing less than 20 kilograms
- Any other scrap metal material
- Fridges and freezers (doors removed)
- Washing machines, dryers and stoves

### Unacceptable Items

- Cans or tins containing liquids or paint
- Car bodies, large car parts, tyres
- Large scrap metal items above 2 metres and/or unable to be handled by 2 people
- Concrete, asbestos, bricks, rocks, dirt
- Items placed in plastic bags that appear to be hazardous in nature
- Batteries
- Gas bottles, ammunition or explosives
- Domestic recyclables such as glass & plastic bottles, jars and other containers suitable for collection through the kerbside recycling collection service
- Large sheeting and plasterboard sheeting unable to be handled by 2 people
- Liquid waste
- Obvious business waste (e.g. large volumes of identical materials or items)
- Other hazardous waste items as defined under the Environment Protection Act
- Large tree stumps unable to be handled by two people
- Treated pine
