DISTRICT E-WASTE AND MATTRESS COLLECTION



The Berri Barmera Council is providing a second waste collection for township properties and a disposal opportunity for rural properties to assist residents with the disposal of unwanted electronic waste and mattresses.

Further Information

Collection - Township Residents

A collection service will be provided for township residents for the removal of e-waste and mattresses that are too large to be disposed of through regular household waste collections.

For a residential property to be eligible they must be located within township boundaries, which is defined as having a street address, not a rural address.

Excluded properties include, but are not limited to; businesses, commercial premises, vacant land, industrial properties, schools and churches.

Collection will be undertaken as follows:

WEEK 1 - Berri

24 May - 28 May 2021

WEEK 2 - Barmera

31 May - 4 June 2021

WEEK 3 - Minor Towns

7 June - 11 June 2021

Preparing For Your Collection

Collection items must be placed on the nature strip in front of your property on the Sunday before your collection week.

All collections must be placed in an accessible kerbside location outside the premises, close to the kerb line and clear of the road and footpath.

Please avoid parking in front of the collection area.

Disposal - Rural Residents

Rural residents are being provided with the opportunity to dispose of e-waste at one of Councils Works Depots on selected dates.

Proof of rural residency must be presented upon entry.

Mattresses can be dropped off free of charge at the Cleanaway Waste Transfer Station located at 92 Hoskin Road, Monash between 24 May and 11 June 2021. Proof of rural residency must be presented upon entry.

Max. 3 Mattresses per property.

What Is E-waste And What Is Accepted?

E-waste is electronic products that are unwanted, not working, and nearing or at the end of their "useful life." It consists of anything domestic, plugs into a power point, uses a charger or is powered by a battery.

What Is Not Accepted?

Basically, anything that does not fit in the categories above.

These items consist of general waste,

cardboard, cement, batteries, fluoro tubes, water/mud/soil/dirt, tyres, aerosol and paint cans, gases and/or bottles, petrol/oil containers, scrap wood, whiteboards, any other hazardous materials or chemicals including asbestos which needs to be disposed of through a licensed contractor.

Uncollected Items/Early Presentation:

To prevent the townships from looking untidy during this time, residents will be required to place items for collection out on the Sunday of the week of collection.

Early placement may attract a fine under the Local Nuisance and Litter Control Act.

Materials other than those specified in the accepted items section will not be collected.

Cleanaway will provide written notice to the resident if any waste is left uncollected.

Uncollected items must be removed within 24 hours. It is the residents responsibility to do this and failure to do so may attract a fine.
